Jean McMurray, Executive Director of the Worcester County Food Bank (WCFB) was our guest of honor at our annual summer BBQ event. Jean enlightened our residents and staff as to the mission and challenges of the agency. Some eye opening statistics: There are nearly 83,000 people in Worcester County living below the poverty level. Nearly 100,000 people in the county received food assistance from WCFB. Since the 2008 recession the hunger rate for households in MA has increased 40% from 8.3% to 11.4%. Thanks to your generosity, our food drive netted more than 200 lbs. of food to help people in need of assistance.
